



AQUACULTURE/FARM TOURS

WA26T has organized aquaculture/farm tours to some nearby active aquaculture facilities in Bagamoyo - approximately a 2.5-hour drive from Dar es Salaam. Tour participants will visit a seaweed processing facility, a coastal village facility involved in sea cucumber farming, and a large-scale tilapia aquaculture operation that uses In-Pond Raceway System (IPRS) technology. There are 80 seats available for this tour, allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. **Be sure to register early!** The tour cover charge is US\$50, which includes lunch and refreshments. **Departure is strictly 07:00 from JNICC.**

TOUR POINT A:

Healthy Seaweed Company Limited (Seaweed Café™)

A certified seaweed processing facility in Kerege, that transforms raw seaweed into a growing family of certified food products. The company is active in supporting coastal seaweed farms by collecting seaweed, storing in purpose-built warehouse, processing, value addition and operating a distribution network for 7 product lines, reaching nearly 150 retail stores across Tanzania. <https://healthvseaweedcafe.co.tz/>

Beach Management Unit (BMU-PANDE KAOLE)

A coastal fishing community group dedicated to the protection and conservation of fisheries resources in Bagamoyo District, Pwani Region, Tanzania. In addition to their conservation activities, the BMU members are also engaged in sea cucumber farming



TOUR POINT C:

TANLAPIA Ltd

TANLAPIA Ltd is a large-scale tilapia operation that uses In-Pond Raceway System (IPRS) It has a large-scale tilapia operation using In-Pond Raceway System (IPRS) technology. The farm is on 500 ha of rich, green plains at the mouth of the Ruvu River.
