Each year since 2023, the WAS African Chapter (WAS-AC) will celebrate individuals, companies and organisations who have made significant contributions to the Chapter and to the development of aquaculture in Africa, in fields of scientific research, education, technological innovations, communications and information exchange. These recipients have transformed our understanding of aquaculture in Africa, impacted many aquaculture actors positively by contributing to solutions for the advancement of sustainable aquaculture in Africa.

Honourees and awardees were celebrated this year at the Aquaculture Africa 2024 Conference (A-FRAQ24) in Hammamet, Tunisia (19 to 22 November 2024) - where over 1200 attendees from more than 70 countries gathered. The awards were presented by the Guest of Honor, Tunisian Minister of Agriculture, Water Resources and Fisheries (Hon. Ezzedine Ben Chiekh) and WAS-AC President (Ms Foluke Areola) witnessed by the African Union Development Agency (AUDA-NEPAD) and other high-level state guests.
